The raging waters plunges in 275 falls over a 2,4km wide jungle frontage. **Optional** (not included) guided excursion to visit www.parquedasaves.com.br Brazil's most spectacular bird sanctuary in the afternoon. Walk through the 12

acres (4.8 hectares) of subtropical forest to see several native species of birds in their natural habitat. Listen for birdcalls, the flash of brightly colored wings and have your camera at the ready. This park is a refuge and sanctuary for many bird species, including macaws, golden parakeets, harpy eagles and toucans. Weather permitting, we venture deep inside the salt flats to Incawasi Island. Climb with your guide to the island's summit and enjoy spectacular vistas of the vast salt desert. 
