#### Day 1 • Quito, Ecuador Arrival

Meet and greet at Quito airport by your personal tour guide in Ecuador. Private transportation to selected hotel for registration. 3-Nights hotel stay in Quito.

**Day 2 • Quito Panoramic and Equatorial Tour** (B/L) 09:00 pickup for a small group guided Quito city tour. Built on a carpet of ancient Incan ruins, Ecuador's bustling capital was the first city to be declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site. We visit the historic city

center and San Francisco the first church built in Quito. We proceed to La Compañia de Jesus. This Jesuit church is one of the great baroque masterpieces in South America. All the work took 160 years. We continue to La Mitad del Mundo (The Middle of the World) and Quitsato Mitad del Mundo Monument. A visitor with one foot in either hemisphere, straddling the Equator. Ciudad La Mitad del Mundo is a complex set up on the site where, in 1736, French explorer and scientist Charles-Marie de la Condamine made his final calculations to determine the precise equatorial line. Lunch included. Transfer back to the hotel.

#### Day 3 • Quito • Baltra Airport • Galapagos Islands • Santa Cruz Island (B/L/D)

Private transfer to the Quito Airport. Assistance at the airport. Departure to Baltra, Galapagos Islands. Assistance, meet and greet at Baltra airport, Santa Cruz Island. The island of Santa Cruz has the largest and most developed town in the Galápagos. Travelers pass through an airport inspection point to insure that no foreign plants or animals are introduced to the islands. Guided transportation to the harbor or to your hotel. A visit to the Charles Darwin Research Center is always included in our programs. Stop by the baby-tortoise house! Select your **hotel stay** on the island, an **island hopping program** or an **inclusive cruise tour** with daily guided shore excursions on board your preferred Galapagos vessel.

#### Day 7 • Santa Cruz • Baltra • Quito (B)

Guided land excursion to visit the highlands on Santa Cruz Island in the morning. Shuttle transportation to the Baltra airport. Departure flight back to Quito. Assistance, meet and greet at Quito airport by your personal tour guide. Private transfer to your hotel. Registration. 2-Nights hotel accommodation in Quito.

#### Day 8 • Otavalo Indian Market Tour (B/L)

07:30 pickup from the hotel for a private guided full day excursion to visit Otavalo Otavalo is one of Ecuador's most popular destinations.

Otavaleños have been famous for their masterful artisanship for centuries. The artisans market in Otavalo is world-renowned. Otavaleños still wear traditional clothing and cling to their heritage. Even non-shoppers will love Otavalo and its surroundings. The town is nestled in the Sunrise Valley in the shadow of two protective volcanoes, Cotacachi and Imbabura. Outside Otavalo we visit weavers' studios in Peguche, leather shops in Cotacachi, and woodcarving workshops in San Antonio de Ibarra. Lunch. Return

## Day 9 • Quito • Cotopaxi Volcano • Quilotoa Lagoon • Salcedo • Riobamba (B/L)

07:00 pickup and departure after breakfast. Private escorted journey. We travel towards the Cotopaxi Volcano for a brief visit to the park museum. We continue towards the spectacular Quilotoa Lagoon. One of our most popular excursions is a circuit known as the Quilotoa Loop. The roads pass through lovely, isolated mountain villages and hamlets, many of whose inhabitants cling to their ancient indigenous heritage and ways. Whichever direction you choose, Laguna Quilotoa, a beautiful, high-mountain lake formed in the broad crater of an extinct volcano. The views of the emerald-green lake are striking from the parking area, but many folks are tempted to hike down the steep slopes of the crater to the water's edge. The distance to the water seems deceptively short, and the climb down is relatively quick, but the climb back up is quite steep and can take over an hour. Optional mule-ride-back to the top USD \$10 pp. approximately. Other hiking options include the narrow and rugged trail around the crater rim, where the vistas are breathtaking. For lunch, we drive to the beautiful www.rumipamba.com restaurant in Salcedo.

Day 9 • Salcedo • Riobamba (continuation)

After lunch, we continue our journey to the picturesque town of Riobamba 2,750 meters. Hotel registration. Shadowed by five spectacular snowcapped peaks in the heart of the Ecuadorean central highlands, Riobamba is an enchanting small city, with attractive 18<sup>th</sup> century architecture, lush parks, interesting museums, and charming churches. 1-Night hotel in Riobamba.

# Day 10 • Riobamba • Alausi • Devils Nose Train Ingapirca Inca Ruins • Guayaquil (B/L)

06:00 early departure to the Alausi railway station. 10:00 travel by train on the famous Devil's Nose

track. Enjoy this amazing journey over the Andes Mountains. Arrival at Sibambe station for a cultural performance. Return by train to Alausi. 13:00 we proceed towards the ancient Ingapirca ruins. After lunch, participate on a private guided visit of the historical Inca site. Ingapirca means the wall of the Inca, and you can see some fine examples of the famed Inca masonry here. The highlight of the site is El Adoratorio | Castillo, an elliptical structure believed to be a temple to the sun.

We continue to Guayaquil. Private guided panoramic city tour of Guayaquil. Guayaquil's new ravishing waterfront is right next to Santa Ana Hill, its oldest neighborhood, and iguanas roam freely at Bolivar Park in the heart of downtown. Guayaquil is Ecuador's natural port and its largest city with a population of two million. It is also the country's financial and commercial center. Founded in 1547, this tropical city lies on the banks of the Guayas River, twelve miles inland from the Gulf of Guayaquil. The people of Guayaquil are outgoing and open. Transfer to your selected hotel in the afternoon. Optional dinner at selected restaurant. 1-Night hotel accommodation in Guayaquil.
